Direct Disclosure Requirement

In accordance with federal regulations, if a student is located in a state where the Elementary Education program:

- Does not meet educational requirements, or
- A determination has not been made

Elizabeth City State University will provide direct written notification to the student prior to enrollment or within 14 calendar days of becoming aware of the student's location.

Students may be required to complete an attestation acknowledging this information before continuing in the program.

Student Location Statement

Determinations regarding whether a program meets educational requirements for professional licensure or certification are based on the student's location at the time of initial enrollment. Requirements may change, and students who relocate during their program should consult with their program advisor and the appropriate licensing agency.

Student Responsibility

It is the responsibility of the student to:

- Confirm licensure requirements in their state of residence
- Contact the appropriate state licensing board
- Understand that licensure requirements may change at any time

Completion of the Elementary Education program does not guarantee licensure in any state outside of North Carolina.
